

- Pre-proposals/full proposals must be written in English and respect the template form (in terms of overall size, limit of pages – no more than 12 pages for the pre-proposal - and characters).



Règles d'éligibilités

Même type que les ERA-NET ENUAC

- Règles d'application nationales
- at <u>least three eligible applicants from at</u> <u>least three participating countries</u>



Applicants (EN-UAC)

Applicants are defined as organisations/institutions/companies (*l.e.* legal entities).

The Principal Investigator (PI) is defined as the person who is the lead investigator for an Applicant.

The Main Applicant coordinates the whole project.

In addition, a proposal must have at least two additional Coapplicants.

The proposal may also include Co-operation Partners.

Each PI must only participate in a maximum of two proposals, and only once as the PI of a Main Applicant



Applicants (EN-UAC)

Applicants can be organisations such as:

- Companies (from industry/large companies to SMEs)
- Cities, municipalities, regions, regional development agencies, public transport authorities
- Consumers (e.g. business enterprises, test households, etc.)
- Citizens' representatives, NGOs
- Research organisations (universities, university colleges, research institutes or other authorities with research undertakings)

a specific funding agency may not fund each type of organisation. If a partner is not eligible for funding, the partner can still participate as cooperation partner.



Applicants (EN-UAC)

- Research organisations
- Urban government authorities
- Companies and commercial organisations
- Consumers
- Civil Society

For EN-UAC: At least one consortium partner must be an urban public authority



Urban public authority (EN-UAC)

an urban public authority for ANR is a "collectivité territoriale (communes, départements, régions, collectivités à statut particuliers, collectivités d'outre-mer, EPCI, groupement de collectivités …)".



At least on French Research Entity (EN-UAC)

A proposal eligible for an ANR funding must involve at least one French public research entity and/or for diffusion of knowledge (e.g. EPST, university, "EPIC de recherche") or one private research entity and/or for diffusion of knowledge which has its headquarters or a subsidiary in France and which is not a commercial society.



Funding (EN-UAC China Call)

The funding rate is determined according to the classification of the entity in the European regulation.

- For entities eligible for a funding "à coût marginal" (public entities) ANR grants cover only additional costs of the research projects (100% cout marginal)
- For entities eligible for a funding "à coût complet" (others) ANR grants cover the whole costs of the research projects according to different rates depending on the European category. The determining criterion is the exercise of an economic activity:
 - For associations that are Research Organisation (according to the European regulation), ANR grants cover 50% of the full costs of the research projects;
 - For entities are Company (according to the European regulation): SME, ANR grants covers 45% of the full costs, 35% for experimental development;
 - For large companies, ANR grants cover 30% of the full costs for basic and industrial research projects, 25% for experimental development.

For EPIC research organisations (CEA, BRGM, CSTB ...), ANR covers 50% of the full costs of the research if a company (trading company) is in the consortium, self-funded or funded by ANR
